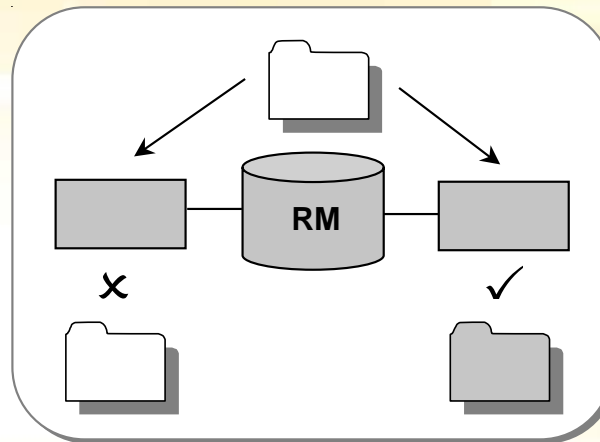

1. A lecturer discovers a web resource he wishes to use to support his course, enters the Blackboard interface to add link to course listing, and follows instructions given.

4. If it is a resource that ANGEL does not recognise the link is posted as normal, and the lecturer is prompted to get the resource included in the Resource Manager.



2. Normally this link would be posted directly to the page, formatted using the information provided by the lecturer. Information about the resource is not stored anywhere in Blackboard, so it cannot be centrally maintained or shared with other course designers.

3. Using the ANGEL system, the resource is checked against the known resources in the RM. If it is one of the supported resources (an e-journal, an RDN resource) that the RM knows about then a persistent URL is returned. This can then be maintained via the RM.
